General Information

INSPRAY 90 is a general purpose, low foam non-ionic spreader/activator for use on plants to maximize the effectiveness of insecticides, herbicides (aquatic and terrestrial), fungicides, defoliants and dessicants. It is designed for quick wetting, uniform droplet distribution and increased spray retention on leaf and stem surfaces. INSPRAY 90 incorporates the properties of a spreader and an activator to improve wetting, spreading, contact activity and penetration.

Directions For Use

With herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, defoliants and desiccants: Add 1/2 to 4 pints per 100 gallons of water during mixing. For specific rates of surfactant, always refer to the pesticide manufacturers' label.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mists or vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE): long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, gloves, and protective eyewear.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give ANY liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, locked area out of reach of children. Protect from excessive heat. Keep container tightly closed in storage to prevent entry of water.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
